In our school, we will respect children and adults and help to protect your rights to be safe and to feel safe.

All the adults around you think that your health, safety and well-being are very important.

We do our best to help you make good progress, not just in reading, writing, maths, art, PE... but in also sharing your thoughts and feelings, helping one other, learning how to sort out problems and feeling well in mind and body.

How will we do this?

We will work together to make school a safe place for you to learn in; we will talk with you and listen to you.

We will teach you how to recognise risks in different situations, how to protect yourselves, how to ask for help and how to stay safe.

We will do our best to make sure that you remain safe, at home as well as in school, by listening to you and one another.
